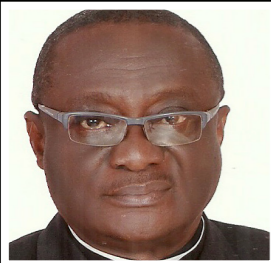
Chairman Wichtech Group of Companies
